BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2024-233-AA-DGP

"A RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 23-4520 TO CITY-WEST MOTORS CORPORATION"

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Pampanga published in accordance with RA 9184 and its Updated RIRR an invitation to bid for P.R. # 23-4520 > Supply and delivery of 100 units - Passenger Van with an approved budget for the contract in the amount of One Hundred Forty Million Pesos, Philippine Currency (PhP 140,000,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid invitation, a public bidding was held on January 03, 2024, wherein two (2) bidders, namely: MCX International, Inc. and City **West Motors Corporation** submitted their bids:

WHEREAS, after the preliminary examination of bids, the BAC, using a nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the submissions of the abovecited bidders as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, after the detailed evaluation of the bids, the bids were ranked based on the submissions to identify the lowest calculated bid, as follows:

1. MCX International, Inc.

PhP 138,400,000.00

2. City West Motors Corporation -

PhP 139,950,000.00

WHEREAS, based on the above evaluation, the BAC declared the submission of MCX International, Inc. as the Lowest Calculated Bid in the amount of PhP 138,400,000.00;

WHEREAS, during the post-qualification process, the bid of MCX International, Inc. was found to be non-responsive due to the inability of the bidder to complete a contract rendering unsatisfactory and questionable performance in its capability to fulfill a contract and the brand of the product being offered did not meet the required number of years, which is at least 10 years, available in the Philippine Market to assure availability of parts and after sales service;

WHEREAS, based on the results of the post-qualification of the bid submission of MCX International, Inc., the BAC declared the post-disqualification of MCX International, Inc. without prejudice to whatever remedy the bidder may wish to take, and instructed the Secretariat to notify the bidder of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;

WHEREAS, the BAC instructed the TWG to conduct the post-qualification process on the bidder with second Lowest Calculated Bid, **City-West Motors Corporation**;

WHEREAS, MCX International, Inc. timely filed its Motion for Reconsideration which was denied by the Committee in its Resolution No. 2024-020-DGP dated January 24, 2024; copy of which was furnished MCX International, Inc.;

WHEREAS, Section 34.6 of the 2016 Updated RIRR of RA 9184 provides that "immediately after the BAC has notified the first bidder of its post-disqualification, and notwithstanding any pending request for reconsideration thereof, the BAC shall initiate and complete the same post-qualification on the bidder with the second Lowest Calculated Bid/Highest Rated Bid. If the second bidder passes post-qualification, and provided that the request for reconsideration of the first bidder has been denied, the second bidder shall be post-qualified as the bidder with the LCRB or HRRB.";

WHEREAS, considering the foregoing and after careful examination, validation and verification of all statements made and documents submitted by the City-West Motors Corporation, as stated in the bidding documents, the BAC found that the submission of the City-West Motors Corporation passed all criteria for qualification.

WHEREAS, MCX International, Inc. did not file a protest;

NOW THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, in regular session assembled, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, the following:

- To declare the bid of the City-West Corporation in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Nine Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP 139,950,000.00) as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid in accordance with Section 34.4 of the Updated RIRR of RA 9184;
- 2) To recommend the award of the contract to the **City-West Motors Corporation** in the abovemetioned amount in accordance with Section 37.1 of the same RIRR.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, to submit the foregoing recommendations to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) for approval.
