Project Title: Supply and Delivery of Bamboo Propagules

Rationale:

Bamboo is highly valued for its numerous ecological benefits. Its rapid growth, adaptability to diverse environments, and effective prevention of soil and coastal erosion through its extensive root system make it an ideal choice for ecosystem restoration. This project aims to procure propagules of *Kawayan Tinik* (*Bambusa blumeana*) specifically to address soil erosion issues along major riverbanks and waterways within the province.

According to the Bamboo Technoguide by the Department of Agriculture, Kawayan Tinik (Bambusa blumeana) is the most extensively distributed bamboo species in the Philippines, found almost everywhere except in high elevation areas. Its superior strength, durability, and large culm size make this species highly valuable and useful. It is utilized as raw material for construction, furniture, parquet flooring, concrete reinforcement, kitchen utensils, chopsticks, hats, toys, papermaking, basketry, and farming implements.

Approved Budget for the Contract

The ABC for the procurement of bamboo propagules is **FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS ONLY** (₱500,000.00) under the 2024 LDRRM Fund inclusive of all applicable government taxes and charges.
