KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Agreement made and entered into by and between [PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF PAMPANGA], with office address at Capitol Compound, Barangay Sto. Nino, City of San Fernando (P), represented herein by DENNIS G. PINEDA, Provincial Governor and hereafter referred to as the "PROCURING ENTITY".

and

[KARPAM GENERAL MERCHANDISE], a duly registered entity existing under the laws of the Philippines with postal address at 1165 Orion St., St. Jude, Malinta, City of Valenzuela represented by its Authorized Representative, MS. MARY JANE B. SANTIAGO, hereinafter referred to as the "THE SUPPLIER",

WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, THE PROCURING ENTITY decided to use Framework Agreement on its procurement project Supply and Delivery of 15,000 cavans – Well-Milled Commercial Rice (Single Year Framework Agreement);

WHEREAS, this Agreement is for the option to purchase of goods determined to be necessary and desirable to address and satisfy the needs of **THE PROCURING ENTITY** but by its nature, use or characteristic, the quantity and/or exact time of need cannot be accurately pre-determined.

WHEREAS, THE PROCURING ENTITY has the option to purchase the items provided in the Framework Agreement List, attached and made an integral part of this Agreement as provided in Article I, on a date and time to be determined in the Call-Off to be issued for such purpose by THE PROCURING ENTITY; and

WHEREAS, THE SUPPLIER which passed the eligibility screening conducted by **THE PROCURING ENTITY**, shall maintain and update the eligibility requirements during period of this Agreement and shall honor all obligation under this Framework Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Article I GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

 This Framework Agreement is an option contract. THE PROCURING ENTITY is given the option to either purchase the identified items in the Framework Agreement or not to purchase at all.  - (a) the Supplier's Bid, including the Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents/statements submitted (e.g. bidder's response to clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
 - (b) the Framework Agreement List and the Technical Specifications;
 - (c) the General Conditions of Contract;
 - (d) the Special Conditions of Contract;
 - (e) the Performance Security or Performance Securing Declaration;
 - (f) the Procuring Entity's Notice to Execute Framework Agreement;
 - (g) Mini Competition, when necessary; and
 - (h) Call-Offs.

Article II DURATION

The term of this Agreement shall be one (1) year from the date of execution unless sooner revoked by both parties.

Article III CONSIDERATION

For the consideration of one peso (Php 1.00), **THE PROCURING ENTITY** has the option to purchase any or all of the items in the Framework Agreement List through the Issuance of Call-Off and **THE SUPPLIER** commits to deliver the goods and perform the services subject to the conditions of the Call-Off.
