BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2024-826 A-DGP

"A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT TO MEKENI FOOD CORPORATION FOR PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 24-6174 THROUGH REPEAT ORDER"

WHEREAS, the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office requested for Purchase Request No. 24-6174 for the Procurement of additional 50,000 pieces Frozen Whole Chicken and 50,000 packs of 1 kilo Frozen Hotdogs under the Needy Kapampangan Program with an Approved Budget for the Contract in the amount of Php 28,476,000.00;

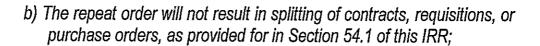
WHEREAS, inasmuch as there was a contract for the same items previously awarded through competitive bidding, the Committee referred the said purchase request and its attachments to the Technical Working Group for evaluation and comment if the same may be procured through Repeat Order;

WHEREAS, in its letter dated December 12, 2024, the TWG submitted the following comments:

"Section 51 of the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184 provides:

Repeat Order, when provided for in the APP, is a method of procurement of Goods from the previous winning bidder, whenever there is a need to replenish goods procured under a contract previously awarded through Competitive Bidding. Repeat Orders shall likewise be subject to the following conditions:

a) Unit prices of the repeat order must be the same or lower than those in the original contract; Provided, That such prices are still the most advantageous to the GoP after price verification;



- c) Except in cases duly approved by the GPPB, the repeat orders shall be availed of only within six (6) months from the date of the Notice to Proceed arising from the original contract; Provided, That there has been a partial delivery, inspection and acceptance of the goods within the same 6-month period; and
- d) Repeat Orders shall not exceed twenty-five (25%) of the quantity of each item in the original contract. In order not to exceed the 25% threshold, the goods under the original contract must be:
 - i. Quantifiable
 - ii. Divisible; and
 - iii. Consisting of at least (4) units per item.

WHEREAS, based on the above, the TWG recommended the procurement of Purchase Request No. 24-6174 through Repeat Order;

WHEREAS, Section 51 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184 authorizes resorting to Repeat Order from the previous winning bidder "whenever there is a need to replenish goods procured under a contract previously awarded through competitive bidding" provided that the conditions imposed therein are met;

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, the Bids and Awards Committee, in regular session:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to recommend the award of the contract through Repeat Order to MEKENI FOOD CORPORATION for Purchase Request No. 24-6174 for the Procurement of additional 50,000 pieces Frozen Whole Chicken and 50,000 packs of 1 kilo Frozen Hotdogs under the Needy Kapampangan Program with an Approved Budget of the Contract in the amount of PhP 28,476,000.00 pursuant to RA 9184 and its Revised IRR.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to submit the foregoing recommendations to the Head of the Procuring Entity for approval;
