**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Pampanga published in accordance with RA 9184 and its Updated RIRR an invitation to bid for **P.R. # 24-3769 – Supply and Delivery of 18 units – Desktop and 2 units – Laptop Computer** with an approved budget for the contract in the amount of **One Million Forty Two Thousand Pesos, Philippine Currency (PhP 1,042,000.00)**;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforesaid invitation, a public bidding was held on November 27, 2024 wherein two (2) bidders, namely: **Lhanz CJ Trading & Computer Center, Inc.** and **Oceanlink Marketing Corporation** submitted their bids;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC-TWG determined the submissions of the abovesited bidder as having "passed" all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the bidding documents using a non-discretionary "pass-fail" criteria after the preliminary examination of bids;

**WHEREAS**, after the detailed evaluation of the bids, the bids were ranked based on the submissions to identify the lowest calculated bid, as follows:

1. **Lhanz CJ Trading & Computer Center, Inc.** - **PhP 1,000,320.00**
2. **Oceanlink Marketing Corporation** - **PhP 1,040,000.00**

**WHEREAS**, based on the above evaluation, the BAC declared the submission of **Lhanz CJ Trading & Computer Center, Inc.** as the **Lowest Calculated Bid** in the amount of **PhP 1,000,320.00**;



**BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2025-1-072-1 -DGP**

**“A RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 24-3677  
TO BESTVALUE COMMERCIAL CORPORATION”**

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**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Pampanga published in accordance with law an invitation to bid for **P.R. # 24-3677 – Supply and delivery of Various Office Supplies (Re-bidding)** with an approved budget for the contract in the amount of Two Million Thirty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos, Philippine Currency (PhP 2,036,800.00);

**WHEREAS**, a failure of bidding was declared on September 25, 2024 under BAC Resolution No. .269 - DGP;

**WHEREAS**, upon request of the Provincial Assessor, the said Purchase Request was resolved for re-bidding and the second Invitation to Bid was published on November 20, 2024 (BAC Resolution No. 323-A – DGP dated November 13, 2024);

**WHEREAS**, during the submission and opening of bids on December 12, 2024, two (2) bidders submitted their bids, namely, **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** and **G-Well General Merchandise**;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC-TWG determined the submissions of the abovesited bidder as having “passed” all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the bidding documents using a non-discretionary “pass-fail” criteria after the preliminary examination of bids;

**WHEREAS**, after the detailed evaluation of the bids, the bids were ranked based on the submissions to identify the lowest calculated bid, as follows:

1. **G-Well General Merchandise** - **PhP 2,017,730.00**
2. **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** - **PhP 2,030,300.00**

**WHEREAS**, based on the above evaluation, the BAC declared the submission of **G-Well General Merchandise** as the Lowest Calculated Bid in the amount of **PhP 2,017,730.00**;

**WHEREAS**, during the post-qualification process, the bid of **G-Well General Merchandise** was found to have "**Failed**" on the following grounds:

1. Non-compliant with the project category requirement as per ITB Clause 5.3 "Office Supplies". Indicated in its SLCC "Grocery Items/Canned Goods" rendering its bid non-complying with the mandatory provisions of GPPB-Resolution No. 16-2020 Item K-iii.

**WHEREAS**, Sections 34.5 and 34.6 of the Updated IRR of RA 9184 provide that if the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid fails the criteria for post-qualification, it shall immediately notify the bidder in writing of its post-qualification and the grounds for it and notwithstanding any pending request for reconsideration thereof, the BAC shall initiate and complete the same post-qualification process on the bidder with the second lowest calculated bid;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC declared the post-disqualification of **G-Well General Merchandise**, and instructed the Secretariat to notify the bidder of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC instructed the TWG to conduct the post-qualification process on the bidder with the second Lowest Calculated Bid, **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** without prejudice to whatever remedy **G-Well General Merchandise** may wish to take;

**WHEREAS**, **G-Well General Merchandise** did not file a motion for reconsideration within the required period;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all statements made and documents submitted by **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** as stated in the bidding documents, the BAC found that its bid passed all criteria for post-qualification and recommended the award of the contract in its favor which was adopted by the committee;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, in regular session assembled, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, the following:

- 1) To declare the bid of **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** in the amount of **Two Million Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Pesos, Philippine Currency**

(Php 2,030,300.00) as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid in accordance with Section 34.4 in relation to Section 34.6 of the Updated RIRR of RA 9184;

- 2) To recommend the award of the contract to the **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** in the abovementioned amount in accordance with Section 37.1 of the same RIRR.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to submit the foregoing recommendation to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) for approval.
