"A RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 24-3769 TO OCEANLINK MARKETING CORPORATION"

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Pampanga published in accordance with RA 9184 and its Updated RIRR an invitation to bid for P.R. # 24-3769 — Supply and Delivery of 18 units — Desktop and 2 units — Laptop Computer with an approved budget for the contract in the amount of One Million Forty Two Thousand Pesos, Philippine Currency (PhP 1,042,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid invitation, a public bidding was held on November 27, 2024 wherein two (2) bidders, namely: Lhanz CJ Trading & Computer Center, Inc. and Oceanlink Marketing Corporation submitted their bids;

WHEREAS, the BAC-TWG determined the submissions of the abovecited bidder as having "passed" all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the bidding documents using a non-discretionary "pass-fail" criteria after the preliminary examination of bids;

WHEREAS, after the detailed evaluation of the bids, the bids were ranked based on the submissions to identify the lowest calculated bid, as follows:

2. Oceanlink Marketing Corporation - PhP 1,040,000.00

WHEREAS, based on the above evaluation, the BAC declared the submission of Lhanz CJ Trading & Computer Center, Inc. as the Lowest Calculated Bid in the amount of PhP 1,000,320.00;

BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2025-1-071-1 -DGP

"A RESOLUTION AWARDING PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 24-3677 TO BESTVALUE COMMERCIAL CORPORATION"

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Pampanga published in accordance with law an invitation to bid for P.R. # 24-3677 – Supply and delivery of Various Office Supplies (Re-bidding) with an approved budget for the contract in the amount of Two Million Thirty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos, Philippine Currency (PhP 2,036,800.00);

WHEREAS, a failure of bidding was declared on September 25, 2024 under BAC Resolution No. <u>269</u> - DGP;

WHEREAS, upon request of the Provincial Assessor, the said Purchase Request was resolved for re-bidding and the second Invitation to Bid was published on November 20, 2024 (BAC Resolution No. <u>323-A</u> – DGP dated November 13, 2024);

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of bids on December 12, 2024, two (2) bidders submitted their bids, namely, Bestvalue Commercial Corporation and G-Well General Merchandise;

WHEREAS, the BAC-TWG determined the submissions of the abovecited bidder as having "passed" all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the bidding documents using a non-discretionary "pass-fail" criteria after the preliminary examination of bids;

WHEREAS, after the detailed evaluation of the bids, the bids were ranked based on the submissions to identify the lowest calculated bid, as follows:

- 1. G-Well General Merchandise
- PhP 2,017,730.00
- 2. Bestvalue Commercial Corporation
- PhP 2,030,300.00

WHEREAS, based on the above evaluation, the BAC declared the submission of G-Well General Merchandise as the Lowest Calculated Bid in the amount of PhP 2,017,730.00;

WHEREAS, during the post-qualification process, the bid of **G-Well General Merchandise** was found to have "Failed" on the following grounds:

Non-compliant with the project category requirement as per ITB Clause 5.3
"Office Supplies". Indicated in its SLCC "Grocery Items/Canned Goods"
rendering its bid non-complying with the mandatory provisions of GPPBResolution No. 16-2020 Item K-iii.

WHEREAS, Sections 34.5 and 34.6 of the Updated IRR of RA 9184 provide that if the BAC determines that the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid fails the criteria for post-qualification, it shall immediately notify the bidder in writing of its post-qualification and the grounds for it and notwithstanding any pending request for reconsideration thereof, the BAC shall initiate and complete the same post-qualification process on the bidder with the second lowest calculated bid:

WHEREAS, the BAC declared the post-disqualification of **G-Well General Merchandise**, and instructed the Secretariat to notify the bidder of its post-disqualification and the grounds for it;

WHEREAS, the BAC instructed the TWG to conduct the post-qualification process on the bidder with the second Lowest Calculated Bid, Bestvalue Commercial Corporation without prejudice to whatever remedy G-Well General Merchandise may wish to take;

WHEREAS, G-Well General Merchandise did not file a motion for reconsideration within the required period;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all statements made and documents submitted by Bestvalue Commercial Corporation as stated in the bidding documents, the BAC found that its bid passed all criteria for post-qualification and recommended the award of the contract in its favor which was adopted by the committee:

NOW THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, in regular session assembled, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, the following:

1) To declare the bid of **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** in the amount of **Two Million Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Pesos, Philippine Currency**

(PhP 2,030,300.00) as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid in accordance with Section 34.4 in relation to Section 34.6 of the Updated RIRR of RA 9184;

2) To recommend the award of the contract to the **Bestvalue Commercial Corporation** in the abovementioned amount in accordance with Section 37.1 of the same RIRR.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to submit the foregoing recommendation to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) for approval.
